### Strictly Come Praying



As usual the programme offered some relevant and challenging sessions. **'Too busy to Pray?'** **'How do I hear God speak to me?'** **'I've tried praying and it doesn't seem to work!'** and **'What is the point of Praying when God knows what you are going to say anyway?'** were four topics we looked at. And of course as well as learning about prayer, there was the opportunity to do it...from sharing and praying out loud....to praying silently....to all 400 of us shouting the name of our school and asking God to help us live for Him there!

In our closing worship session we sang with the brilliant band, 'Taste' from Essex. Andy from 'Taste' joined us for our group photo (*below*) and Joy, Andy's wife, shared God's Word with us. She spoke about Daniel. Daniel was someone who showed us that we should have a passion for prayer and not be afraid to speak up about what we believe.

Coming back home in the mini-bus, talk about God continued. What is being a Christian all about? Why is it so difficult to follow Jesus at times? What about baptism? Some who had come to 'Strictly' with us this year for the very first time were full of questions. Young as they are, some of them have since committed their lives to Jesus Christ!

As I think back over a great day – I start to wonder what God's plans may be for Glenrothes if He is stirring our young people to pray like this?
