and our eternal home!


Under the shadow of thy throne

PRAYERS *and* The Lord's Prayer

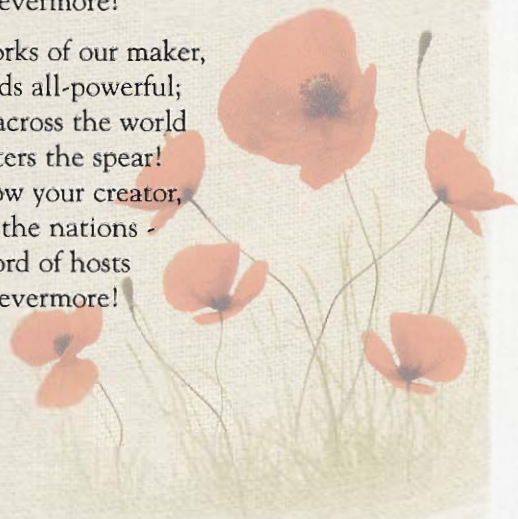
Micah 4: 1 - 4 p932

is with us evermore!



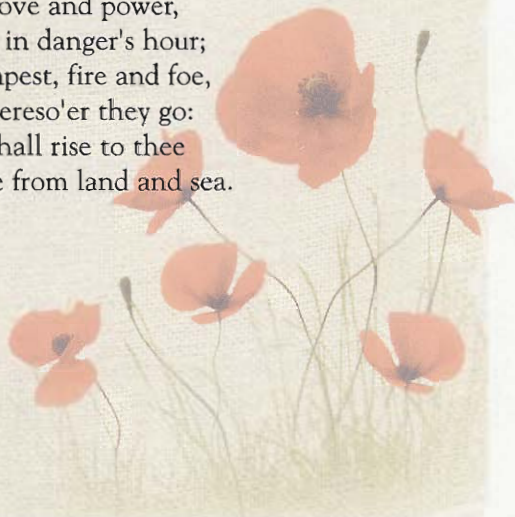
Revelation 7: 11 - 17 p1238

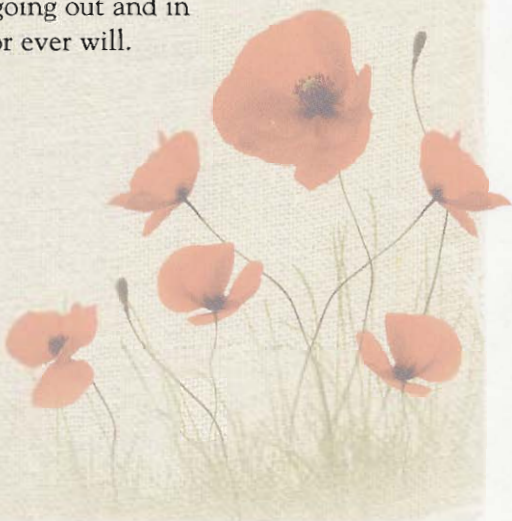
PRAYERS FOR REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY

God keep for ever will.



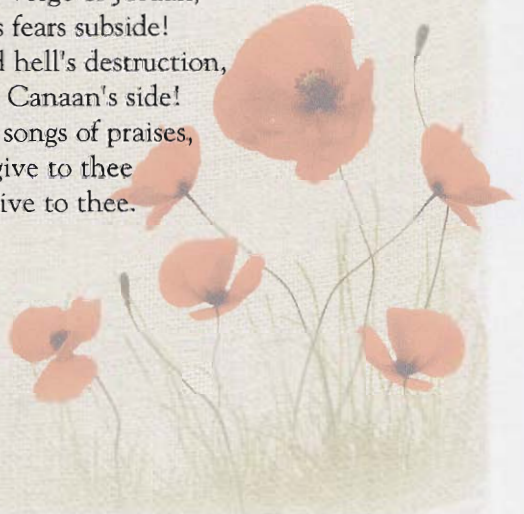
THE SERMON
